PURPOSE:

CRITERIA:

- 2. Club members act as advisors or consultants to the participants.**

PROCEDURES:

Club should assemble a packet of material that includes:

- 1. Completed detailed questionnaire**
- 2. Letter from the school or group emphasizing the value of the program to the children**
- 3. Copies of newspaper articles, photographs and other material that would support the nomination**
- 4. A minimum of one letter of recommendation from an individual who has knowledge of the program**
- 5. Name and address of local newspaper, if applicable**
